The new Advisory Editorial Board will be made of 5 persons who have experience and expertise in the field of solid organ transplantation, transplantation research, and/or research methodology representing organ donor awareness, procurement, medical/surgical care of the donor or recipient, or post-transplant care of persons with end organ failure requiring transplantation. Board members are expected to be members of NATCO and committed to the journal and the publication process. The Advisory Editorial Board will meet (teleconference) with Editor-in-Chief semi-annually and be available for advice and consultation as needed.

To be a part of the Editorial Board for the journal, consider the following characteristics.

1. An editorial board member has a broad experience in transplantation research with a specific area of expertise.
2. An editorial board member has published in the journal.
3. An editorial board member acts as an expert reviewer, creating a high-level evaluation of assigned manuscripts.
4. An editorial board member represents the journal by identifying and recruiting new reviewers and authors.
5. The Editor-in-Chief, with input from the Advisory Editorial Board, will develop and implement a strategic plan that will position the journal for future growth.
